

Costume & Hair Week Information

Week of: May 6 – May 10, 2019

- **COSTUMES & ALTERATIONS:** Please bring your costume to class, WITH ALL NECESSARY ALTERATIONS COMPLETE, HANGING AND COVERED in a garment bag or dark garbage bag during the week of May 6–May 10, 2019.
- **OUTSIDE BUILDING:** Please DO NOT wear any part of your costume or dance shoes outside of the building.
- **CLASS TIME:** Please arrive early enough that you can change into your costume, secure your headpiece and be ready to begin class on time.
- **HAIR:** Please have performer's hair pulled back in a low bun at the base of their neck with a STRAIGHT PART over the performers LEFT eye (no bangs/use hair net). We recommend using DIPPITY DO to hold bangs back and lots of bobby pins and hairspray. We recommend you purchase these supplies earlier rather than later.
- **MAKEUP:** Please **DO NOT** apply stage makeup during costume & hair week. Stage makeup will be worn for pictures, all MU rehearsals and all performances.
- **PANTIES:** NO panties are to be worn under tights or costumes (just like we do not wear panties with bathing suits ☺).
- **TIGHTS & SHOES:** Please wear new performance tights and performance dance shoes (properly sewn ballet and pointe shoes).
- **NAIL POLISH:** Please **DO NOT** wear nail polish on fingers or toes. We suggest removing it before Costume and Hair week and leaving it off until after the Artistic Revue performances.
- **JEWELRY:** Please **DO NOT** wear jewelry with your costumes. We recommend leaving all jewelry at home.

ADDITIONAL COSTUME ALTERATIONS: Instructors will let you know if further changes to your child's costume are needed. We strive to develop a team atmosphere at Elite. Part of this is achieved by presenting uniformity in the dancers costuming.

IMPORTANT REMINDER: ONCE AGAIN, please be sure that all needed sewing etc...is COMPLETE and your child's costume is ready to perform in when you wear it for class **during Costume and Hair week**. It is important for the security of the students that **all alterations be complete on this day**. This is important because the students need to rehearse in the altered costumes (in-studio) before they perform (on-stage) and a possible "costume malfunction" occurs in front of an audience.

STAGE MAKEUP INFORMATION

***DO NOT** apply stage makeup for classes during Costume & Hair Week.

***DO** apply stage makeup for Picture Weekend, Dress Rehearsals (May 13 & 14th), & Performance Days (May 18 & 19).

*****ALL MAKEUP SHOULD BE APPLIED AT HOME. TOUCH-UPS CAN BE MADE AFTER THEY ARRIVE FOR PICTURES AND AT MARSHALL UNIVERSITY.*****

EYE SHADOW: Tan and beige tones of eye shadow

EYE LINER: Apply to top and bottom lids from the center to the outside edges of eyelids

FALSE EYELASHES: All performers wear false eyelashes except Creative Movement (3&4 years old) & Combination (5 years old)

*** Style: Demi 101 black)

*** Apply: to top eyelids

CHEEKS: Blush heavily, apply appropriate for individual skin tone

LIPS: Follow teacher instructions according to costume color (ex. red/pink)
